So we invite you—parents, grandparents, guardians—to make Sunday nights a sacred rhythm. Come alongside us as we work together to build a foundation for our youth that lasts far beyond the teenage years. When we invest in the faith of our young people, we shape the future of the Church—and plant seeds that will bear fruit for generations to come.

Stay tuned as we finalize the start date of our new Youth Program.

We plan on starting during the Summer in June, once a month, and then having a huge kick-off when school starts in August. After school starts, we plan on having it consistently twice a month.

Please keep our families and staff in your prayers as we navigate through this new season of ministry. It sure is an exciting one!




