# Postor's Monthly Message Fond Farewells

am really bad at good-byes. And like most people, even when I know some changes are ultimately going to be good changes, they're still hard. On the one hand, I know I'm following my dream. I know I'm being led to this new adventure in my vocation and that it's the right thing for me to do. God gave me a certain set of gifts and is now leading me to a call where those gifts will be utilized in a way I've always wanted to use them.

Yet, that still comes with a lot of grief and sadness. When you're a pastor, the grief is somehow even more difficult, because in order for me to completely focus on my new congregation and to help make way for the new, incoming pastor here, I can't really have a lot of interaction with Immanuel members (not even on social media) once I am gone for at least that first year. So while I'm gaining a new community, I'm losing another, and that loss is palpable. It's hard to distance yourself from relationships you've spent the better part of eight years developing.

And my goodness have we been through a lot these past eight years! I'd barely just arrived when the senior pastor I was called to work with here at Immanuel announced his retirement about six months later, and I was faced with deciding whether to leave or pivot my role from focusing on adult education ministries to holding things together for the next eighteen months or so during the interim process. I don't regret staying instead of leaving as I do believe I wound up being the stability

and consistency that was needed here. During that timeframe, I also took over the publications role as we were forced to let the media position go due to financial constraints left in the wake of a departing senior pastor.

If you're wondering who will fill that publications role now, a lot of that job will fall to Brittany Peralta, our Youth Director and Contemporary Worship Leader (continued on page 2...)

since she has the creative "flair" necessary for that role. We wind up wearing a lot of hats here at Immanuel! I know some of how that role currently is done will change—honestly changes that should have probably been made some time ago but simply weren't for one reason or another.

Then, once Pastor Chad came on board, I was hopeful once things settled down that I could again start maybe turning my focus back toward the adult education realm... only to have Covid hit us, and we found ourselves scrambling to figure out that new reality. Financially we began to struggle, as did every congregation in the United States, let alone the ELCA, and we began having conversations about the possibility that we would no longer be a congregation that could sustain two full-time pastors. So I began to consider my options for my future, and began to think about what kind of call would I want to go to next.

Then seemingly out of nowhere, we were presented with the possibility of merging with Prince of Peace in Stuart. I know some feel that this merger is why I am leaving, but that is simply not the case. The merger kept me around a year longer than I would have stayed otherwise, and I feel I was very much the right person to love on the Stuart congregation and help them through this transition. And as I understood my role at the time, I felt I could be a pastor that could provide the Stuart site with pastoral care and stability during a painful time as their entire identity had to shift and change.

However, once I realized that mission redevelopment was going to become my primary duty

going forward, I knew at that point I was not the right person for the job. I'm an introvert by nature, so going out and hitting the streets, networking, etc. isn't in my wheelhouse. I thought initially maybe it could be something I would learn to like if it meant not having to uproot my life. I quickly realized, that would not be the case. A small part of why I left Hollywood was I didn't enjoy the networking aspects that were required to truly be successful in that industry.

I feel in order to give Immanuel the best possible chance it can to truly thrive, it will need someone over at the Stuart site whose passion is redevelopment. Those pastors exist, and the merger has now made this site more appealing to potential mission redevelopers. Thus, I feel that in order to be true to my sense of call, it is only right for me to pursue what I feel God has called me to do in order to also make way for someone else who will be following their passion and what they feel God is calling them to do in the realm of redevelopment.

So I continue to feel confident that while God is calling me elsewhere, God has a new path in store for Immanuel and that there is a pastor out there that God has already selected to come here.

While my time here was never exactly what I originally expected (ministry rarely is), it has been an honor and a privilege to walk through all these somewhat tumultuous times with you.

I will miss you all deeply. God's peace and blessings to you all.
