Pastor's Monthly Message Seeds of Growth

few weeks ago, our gospel reading from Mark was the parable of the sower and other parables about seeds. While I confess, I do not have a green thumb, I do have a basic understanding of the growing process. Plant a seed in nutrient rich soil, give it some water and sunlight and it will grow. Remember I said basic understanding, exactly how much water and how much sunlight depends on several factors and in our house, we rarely get that ratio right.

In Jesus parable he detailed various places that scattered seeds may land and how that affects if and how the seeds might grow. After examining the parable, we determined that creating "good soil" is one of the goals and responsibilities of the church. If we can create "good soil" then we will produce a hundred-fold.

What does producing a hundred-fold look like? Does that mean our congregation/worship community will grow 100%? Maybe, but I've never been one to focus on the numbers. Yes, the numbers tell a story but I believe the numbers are a side effect of other things, such as good soil. For instance, if we have a warm and welcoming environment (good soil) for people to practice and express their faith then people's faith will deepen and eventually numbers will result. I guess I'm saying the environment we create affects the fruit we produce.

Continuing this analogy, when seeds begin to grow much of the energy is happening underground, by forming a root system. As the root system grows the plant



then begins to push through the soil where we see the plant begin to sprout. In order for the plant to continue to grow above the surface, the root system must continue to grow below the surface. While the plant pushes deeper below the surface, it also continues to grow above the surface and eventually produces fruit. For us, we must root our faith below the surface in order to sprout and produce fruit.

Just like all seeds are different, so are we. Each seed needs varying ratios of nutrients, sunlight and water to produce fruit. Each one of us also needs different nutrients of faith in order to grow and produce fruit. So here are some things for you to ponder and then share with me.

How can Immanuel deepen your roots of faith? What opportunities can Immanuel provide to help you produce fruit?
