

What is God Revealing Now? by: Pastor Chad

We've made it through the book of Revelation!!! We survived the weird, the symbolism, the numbers, and the beasts. The journey, much like life, can be hard, but if we stay focused on the fact that God loves us, claims us, and redeems us, we can maintain our hope for today and tomorrow. The irony of the book of Revelation is that hope is not the first word people think of when they are asked about Revelation, but hope is the final word.

While I stated that one of my goals for our sermon series on Revelation was that we would not put an "s" at the end, I'd like to challenge us a bit more. God has given us more than one revelation; it is just that John's is the one recorded in scripture. I hope we all know that God's desire is still being revealed to us today. That train of thought led me to these questions: What is God revealing to us today? What is God calling us to? What is our hope for tomorrow?

Perhaps those aren't easy questions to answer. Maybe they aren't questions you've considered, and that's okay. But now that we've worked our way through God's revelation to John, let's devote some time to examining our own congregation and ministries and wrestling with what God's revelation means for us.

I'm asking that each of us spend time in prayer and ask God these questions:

- 1. What current ministry is God calling us to refocus our effort in?
- 2. What new ministry is God calling us to?
- 3. What time and talent has God blessed me with to serve in a new or existing ministry of the church?
- 4. What resources can I give to support the ministry of Immanuel?

Seven years ago, we never would have dreamed of a second campus or creating a village of tiny homes, but God works in unexpected ways and provides opportunities for us to be the light. It is our responsibility to pray regularly for how we can be part of God's mission through the church. It is also our responsibility to give of our time, talent, and treasure to further that mission.

If you survey all of scripture, very rarely does God act alone. Not because God can't do it alone, but because God wants us to participate in the work of the kingdom. Sometimes that means giving extra time. Sometimes that means giving extra money, maybe skipping Starbucks or Taco Tuesday (yes, even tacos).

If we are going to "Be the Light," we need to have the voice, hands, feet, and resources to make that light shine.

And don't forget, our next Youth Group will be on Sunday, September 28th at 6 pm in the Palm City Sanctuary. Mark your calendars and invite a friend!











